Open Call to Artists

The City of Redding is seeking artists to display their artwork in both **City Hall** and the **Redding Library** during 2011.

With over 500 feet of gallery railing, City Hall is the largest art gallery in Redding. The Redding Library is visited by more than 1,600 patrons each day.

21 artists, group of artists or schools will be chosen to produce original works of art.

Selections for this Call are made by a panel consisting of the City's Art in Public Places Committee and members of City staff. New exhibits are hung three times each year and the artwork is carefully selected to provide an engaging experience.

Since the program's inception, more than 1,900 pieces of artwork from more than 160 artists have been exhibited.

Submission Requirements

- ✧ Entry Form
- ✧ Artist bio
- ✧ Brief description of proposed artwork
- ✧ Samples of artwork in the form of three pages of color photos, as follows:
 - 4 photos per page with white space between each. Page to be letter size.
- ✧ NO original artwork is to be submitted.
- ✧ Proof of Membership in the Shasta County Arts Council

Incomplete submissions will not be considered.

Submission can be mailed to the Facilitator or delivered in person during regular business hours.

Artist Responsibilities

(once selected)

- ✧ Exhibited art must be original artwork, no reproductions will be accepted.
- ✧ Artist is responsible for the installation and removal of artwork.
- ✧ Artist must attend an orientation meeting.
- ✧ Artist must be present at exhibit reception.
- ✧ Artist to provide City with three digital images of artwork, to be used for promotional purposes.
- ✧ Artwork should be available for the entire exhibit.
- ✧ Artist is responsible for managing all aspects of artwork sales directly with buyer.

The City of Redding receives no commission on the sale of the art.
