John Chase, subcontractor for the Big League Dreams (BLD) Sports Complex project, stated that a number of businesses suffered and are still suffering over the construction debacle of BLD project. Mr. Chase indicated that there was no valid reason why the project was not completed in a timely manner, and he recommended that the City implement a permanent course of action to follow when a contractor fails to perform. In light of the negative history with Dale Construction, he requested that the City support the subcontractors and businesses involved with this project by pursuing litigation to the fullest extent.
