

NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT  
AND PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to Federal Aviation Administration Order 5050.4B National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) Implementing Instructions for Airport Actions, notice is hereby given that the City of Redding, California intends to request to be released from various Federal obligations from the Federal Aviation Administration to develop a parcel of land at Redding Municipal Airport for non-aeronautical development. Such development includes a portion of the Stillwater Business Park, consisting of medium- to large-parcel business and industrial sites, infrastructure, utilities, and open space. An Environmental Assessment of the economic, social, and environmental impacts of the proposed land release and subsequent development has been prepared.

A public hearing on the Environmental Assessment will be held during the regularly scheduled Board of Administrative Review meeting on Wednesday, June 6, 2007, at 2 p.m., in the Caldwell Park Conference Room located at City Hall, 777 Cypress Avenue, Redding, California.
