A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDDING AMENDING THE GENERAL PLAN OF THE CITY OF REDDING BY ADOPTING AN AIR QUALITY ELEMENT.

WHEREAS, following the required public hearings, the Planning Commission of the City of Redding recommended to the City Council that the City's General Plan be amended by adopting an Air Quality Element; and

WHEREAS, following the required notices in accordance with law, the City Council held a public hearing on the recommendation, and has carefully considered the evidence at said hearing; and

WHEREAS, it is believed that the Air Quality Element is in compliance with the State of California Air Quality Management laws; the Shasta County Air Quality Attainment Plan of the Air Quality Management District; and the Shasta County Congestion Management Plan;


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Redding hereby adopts the Air Quality Element attached hereto, together with any additions or amendments that Council may direct in its Motion.
