



CITY OF REDDING ADOPT-A-TRAIL PROGRAM GENERAL INFORMATION



Thank you for your interest in the City of Redding's Adopt-a-Trail Program. Becoming an Adopt-a-Trail sponsor is very simple. A representative from your group or organization will need to act as an Adopt-a-Trail Captain (contact person) to coordinate the cleanup / improvement events. For your convenience, we will provide necessary equipment for the cleanup and post a sign in the area you adopt, signifying your participation as an "Adopt-a-Trail" sponsor. Areas adopted for cleanup must be cleaned a minimum of four times per year.

The two enclosed forms that must be completed and returned to the City of Redding's Community Services Department office before the cleanup event are the *Application to Participate* and the *Waiver of Liability*.

All persons who participate must sign the Waiver of Liability prior to participation. For children under 18, a parent must sign the Waiver of Liability for their child in order for the child to participate. Any new persons wanting to join your group for subsequent cleanup events must also sign the Waiver of Liability prior to participation. Please have a copy of these forms with you during the cleanup, as they will serve as your documentation for participating in the City's Adopt-a-Trail Program. Also, please review the enclosed copies of the City's Conditions of Participation and Safety Requirements.

Please call the Community Services Department at (530) 225-4512 at least one week before the cleanup event to reserve the following necessary equipment: Safety vests, safety signs, litter collection tools, and orange plastic bags. We have only a limited amount of equipment, and many groups share the equipment. Equipment is typically available for pick up and return to the Solid Waste Utility within two days of the cleanup event. City collection crews will retrieve the filled, plastic bags during the week following the cleanup event or as time allows. Bags and bulky items; i.e., tires, mattresses, furniture, etc., should be placed along a roadside or other accessible site but in a location that will not obstruct traffic flow nor create a hazard.

Thank you again for your interest in the City of Redding's Adopt-a-Trail Program. We all need to lend a hand to keep our public areas clean and litter free! The City of Redding relies on the dedicated help of service organizations, businesses and individuals, like you, to make the Adopt-a-Trail program successful.
